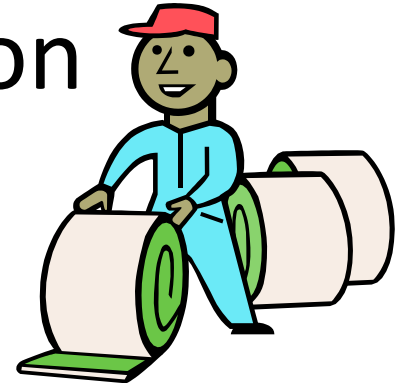

- Plant a Tree program
 - Goal is to plant up to 100 trees in the Village over the next two summers
 - 50/50 Cost splitting with the village and residents.
 - Estimated cost to village will be \$15K-\$30K in 2010.
 - More details to come, want to get Concept Approval tonight.



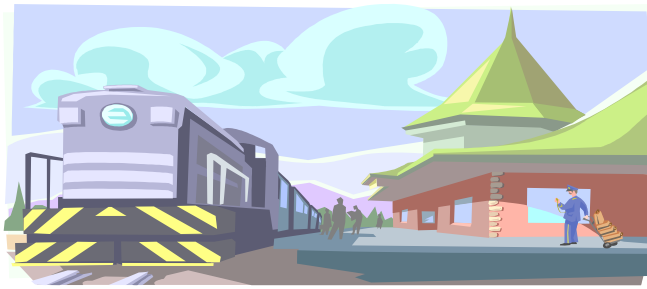
Landscaping Contest

- First Annual Port Chester Landscaping Contest
 - Goal of the No Cost program is to encourage residents to Spruce up their own property and gain recognition.
 - Timing in conjunction with the Village Pride Day.
 - Winners will be awarded plaques, newspaper article/images and have award winning sign placed on front lawn.



Port Chester Beautification

- MTA Train Station Project
 - MTA has pledged \$25k to new landscaping and general beautification of the station.
 - Frank Strauch (Landscape Architect) is donating his design services to the project
 - Create volunteer planting day for bulbs this fall
 - Idea is to create No to Low maintenance plants to Enhance this key gateway to the Village



Port Chester Beautification



- Mural Projects
- To create outdoor art in Port Chester utilizing talents of Port Chester residents and high School.
 - A clay tile event held where children of Port Chester paint a tile to display on wall located at foot of Pearl St. and Boston Post Road. Work with Clay Arts Center, possibly the village Insignia.
 - Murals above the Railroad overpasses.
