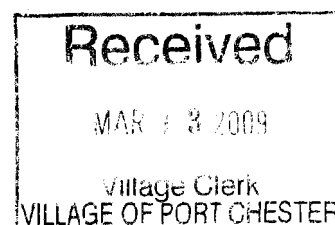

Dear Mayor, Trustees and Taxi Commissioner:

I would like to present you, the Board of Trustees and the Taxi Commissioner the following recommendations as a member of the Strategic Taxi Review Advisory Committee to be consider by the Board.

I. Dispatching Licenses

I would like to recommend for another dispatching license to be granted. *in 2009*

Before any taxi vehicle licenses are granted to existing companies the Village Board should review the number of vehicle licenses own by each company in order to distribute vehicle licenses among the companies that have less vehicles because there are companies that have already too many vehicle licenses.

The Village Clerk's Office is in possession of a taxi driver's waiting list that has been on hold for many years. These drivers should be afforded an opportunity to receive a vehicle driver's license before any licenses are issue to any company.

That list should be review by the Board due to the fact that many drivers who already were granted vehicle licenses sold their license to the companies or other drivers and they went back and added their name to the list. Because of this, there are some drivers that have not had an opportunity to move up on that list.

On January of 2011 the Village of Port Chester and Taxi Commission should adopt a rule depending on business and demand growth before granting any other licenses.

II. Senior Vouchers:

I recommend the Village Government to adopt Mr. Samuel Stanley IZS Consultant) Recommendation to look for more funds to subsidize the seniors cab fares.

Also tokens should be distributed by Village Clerk's Officer or Senior Center Director.

III.

DWI or DUI:

If a driver is stopped/charged and found guilty of driving under the influence, the 1st offense should be 30 days suspension of the license.

On a 2nd offense license should be revoked permanently by the Village Government. We need to make sure our passengers are transport safely.

Finally, I would like to thank you, the trustees, as well as the taxi commission for providing me the opportunity to serve on this committee to try to improve the services provide to our community.
