What is the total Port Chester School District budget for the 2009/2010?
Total approved budget for 2009/2010 is \$75,772,014

What is the breakdown of the 2009/2010, or most recent, budget by administrative, program and capital costs?

Administrative budget is \$7,943,979; Program budget is \$56,407,360; Capital budget is \$11,420,675

What is the cost per pupil during the 2009/2010 school year?

2009/2010 cost per pupil is \$17,388

What percentage of the per pupil cost is paid by local tax levy?

69% of the per pupil cost is paid by local tax levy

After the local tax levy, how is the remainder of the budget paid?

Revenue sources other than the tax levy include: state aid, rental of property, earned interest, commissions, unclassified revenue, payments in lieu of taxes, county sales tax, transfers from other funds and designated fund balance.

How many Port Chester School District school students are bused to public schools?

390 regular and Special Education students are bused to Port Chester public schools.

For the proposed project, where would the assigned bus stop be located for this new residential development?

Bus stop location would not be determined until a definitive list of eligible students is known.
