

A NEW LOCAL LAW IS COMING INTO EFFECT!  
Chapter 302, Towing and Booting

The Village of Port Chester has a new local law, Chapter 302, Towing and Booting, coming into effect that regulates the booting and/or towing of motor vehicles from private property, as defined therein, within the Village of Port Chester.

\*\*\*If you own a towing or booting company that services private parking lots in Port Chester you will be required to get a license from the Port Chester Police Department, and there are many other requirements contained in this law that may affect your business.\*\*\*

\*\*\*If you own commercial or multifamily property (3 units or more), and use, or intend to use, a towing or booting company to service your parking lots, this local law will require your attention. The new local law contains certain requirements, such as signage requirements, which may affect your business.\*\*\*

\*\*\* If you own a car and frequent parking lots in Port Chester, this law may be of interest to you, as the law provides consumers with rights and procedures to protect them from predatory and illicit towing and booting practices.\*\*\*

The Village will begin accepting applications for Towing and Booting Licenses starting May 1, 2016 and the Village will start enforcing the local law on June 1, 2016.

All are invited to attend a “Roll-Out Meeting,” to be held by the Village of Port Chester Police Department on Wednesday, April, 27 2016 at 6:00 P.M., at the **Senior Community Center, 222 Grace Church Street, Port Chester, New York**, to discuss the implementation of this new local law.

This “Roll-Out Meeting” was originally noticed to be at 350 North Main Street, however due to a scheduling conflict the “Roll out Meeting” will be at the **Senior Community Center located at 222 Grace Church Street, Port Chester, New York**.
