Rules for Residential Trash Pickup and Recycling

SANITATION REGULATIONS

Materials may be placed at curbside the evening prior to pickup no earlier than 4:00 PM

HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE

Picked Up Twice Weekly.

Place household garbage in no more than two metal or plastic pails with lids attached. Containers may not exceed 32 gallons in capacity. Total weight of each container when filled may not exceed 75 lbs. Multifamily dwellings are limited to three cubic yards of garbage per pickup.

BULK TRASH

Picked up Wednesdays Except Holiday Weeks.

Includes furniture and refrigerators or equivalent sized items. Total volume may not exceed three 32 gallon containers.

COMINGLED RECYCLABLES

Picked Up Once Weekly

Place the following materials together in a container or box that will be emptied and left for reuse.

Glass – Jars and bottles of all types and colors. Rinse Clean. Labels may remain on along with metal caps. Do not include plastic caps.

Plastic — Bottles and containers labeled with a #1-#7 in the recycling triangle. Rinse clean. Do not include plastic caps. No Bags! Metal — Food and pet food cans. Rinse clean. Labels may remain on and metal lids included. Empty Aerosol Cans. Remove the spray nozzle and plastic cap. Aluminum Foil and Trays. Rinse clean of food particles and residue.

Waxy Cartons – "gabled top" Milk, Egg, Broth, Juice Cartons. Rinse clean do not include plastic caps.

PAPER/CARDBOARD RECYCLABLES

Picked up twice weekly.

Loose Paper — Newspapers including inserts, magazines, junk mail, catalogs, telephone books, office paper and corrugated shipping boxes (free of excessive amounts of plastic tape and food particles). Milk Cartons go in comingle. Place in a brown paper bag, loose in a recycling bin, or tie with twine.

Cardboard – Soft cardboard boxes such as cereal, tissue and gift boxes. Remove any plastic inserts. Flatten boxes together and place in one box or tie together.

Brown Grocery Bags – Fold and place inside another brown grocery bag or use to contain newspaper and junk mail.

GREEN WASTE

Picked up Wednesday Except Holiday Weeks

Includes grass, leaves, small brush, twigs, plants and flowers. Place all material in containers at curbside. Green waste will not be collected if placed in a bag.

Brush and Branches – Bundle together and tie with twin. Branches may not exceed 3 inches in diameter, 3 feet in length or 24 inches in any other dimension.

FALL LEAF PICKUP

October 15th to Dec 15th

Rake loose leaves (no sticks) into piles at the edge of your property. Do not place leaves in street. Crews will vacuum leaves on a neighborhood basis weather permitting.

CHRISTMAS TREES

Place at curbside during the month of January for pickup and mulching. Remove tinsel, plastic ties and ornaments.

FREON

Prior to pickup by the village, refrigerators must have Freon extracted by a professional vendor and a certificate must be attached verifying the removal. Contact Westchester County Recycling for a list of approved vendors.

MEDICATIONS Call PCPD 914 939 1000 E-WASTE

E-waste is not picked up. Deliver these items to the DPW garage on Fox Island Road

No TVs, Computers and monitors, printers, cell phones, electronic devices including kitchen appliances, radios, stereos, old telephones (or just about any other device with a cord) can be left at curbside. (fridges once processed for Freon are considered ok for bulk pickup days.)

NOT ACCEPTED

The following will not be picked up or accepted at the DPW garage. Call a private carting service to dispose of these items or contact Westchester County for more info.

- Paints, Oils or liquids of any kind
- •Hazardous or Toxic material
- Car parts, tires, lubricating oils
- •Compressed gas cylinders
- •Renovation or construction debris and materials
- Styrofoam
- Treated wood
- Brick, stone, concrete, plaster, tile, dirt or similar materials
- •Large tree limbs, logs or stumps
- •Loose or improperly bagged yard debris
- •Recyclables mixed with garbage
- •Medical waste including needles
- •Radioactive waste
- Other items designated non collectible by Westchester County

DPW is located on Fox Island Road. Residents may drop items there year round. Call for fees. Mon-Fri 7:30-11:30 &12:30-3:00 (April 1 – Dec 15 Sat 7:30-11:30)
